## Who are we?

The Community Foundation for Wiltshire & Swindon is a registered charity and grant-making trust. Since 1991 we have been dedicated to strengthening local communities by encouraging local people to support local charities and voluntary organisations.

## Who does the fund support?

### Who can apply?

The fund is open only to individuals (not organisations) to support their educational or learning needs. Individuals benefiting from the fund must either:

- ⇒ Be or have been in the care of Wiltshire County Council or Swindon Borough Council, **OR**
- ⇒ Require additional support because of long term health needs or a disability and are themselves or their parents/carers on means tested benefits

In addition, individuals must:

- ⇒ Be aged between 0 -20, and the grant must be spent before the applicant reaches their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday **AND**
- ⇒ Live within Wiltshire County Council or Swindon Borough Council boundaries, or if not, be educated at an institution that is funded by one of these authorities (including university)



## Who does the fund support?

### Priorities

As the fund is likely to be oversubscribed, priority for funding will be given to individuals:

- ⇒ Who are themselves in receipt of means tested benefits
- ⇒ Whose parents, carers or guardians are in receipt of means tested benefits (where the individual is under 21 and still in full-time education)
- ⇒ Who are in care (where the individual is under 16)
